Purchase your pass at the ticket booth inside Gup's Cruise In precinct and gain access to the legendary Boulevard of Dreams — Powercruise #100's relaxed on-track fat-lappin cruising experience 🌞🚗🔥. For just \$20 per person per night (kids 13 and under FREE), you can cruise your own car around the actual racetrack alongside hundreds of other cars at a relaxed maximum speed of 25km/h while thousands of campers line the infield of the circuit for the first time ever in Powercruise history.

Cruise through themed cruise zones, hit the pedal in the famous Blip Zones 🏎️, roll down the front straight under lights ✨ and soak up the atmosphere as the entire venue transforms into one giant rolling automotive festival. Pull up at your mates' campsite, grab a lemonade 🍹, wander through the bars, food truck precincts 🍔, live band stages 🎸, DJs 🎵 and drive-in movie area 🎬 while cars continue cruising around you all night long.
